Varela Survey, Abstract No. 30, Limestone County, Texas and being a called 293.72 acre tract of land as described in Deed to Goolsby Properties, LLC., recorded as Document No. 124335 of the Deed Records of Limestone County, Texas and a called 181.79 acre tract of land as described in Deed to Goolsby Properties, LLC, recorded as Document No. 2013 3161 of the Deed Records of Limestone County, Texas. Said lot, tract or parcel of land being more particularly described as

BEGINNING at a point in the approximate centerline of Limestone County Road No. 480 at the easterly corner of the said 293.72 acre Goolsby tract from which a 1/2" iron rod found at the northerly corner of a called 99.51 acre tract of land as described in Deed to the City of Groesbeck recorded as Document No. 2013 3709 of the Deed Records of Limestone County, Texas bears S 50° 15' 01" W, 24.52 feet;

THENCE, along the southeasterly line of the said 293.72 acre Goolsby tract as follows: S 50° 15' 01" W, 349.86 feet to a 1/2" iron rod found, S 48° 01' 54" W, 728.89 feet to a 1/2" iron rod found, S 48° 02' 20" W, 345.42 feet to a 1/2" iron rod found, S 48° 08' 29" W, 2351.08 feet to a 4" X 4" stone monument found and S 45° 04' 04" W, passing a 1/2" iron rod found marking the westerly corner of the said City of Groesbeck tract to the right 1.37 feet at 341.25 feet and continuing a total distance of 3805.87 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set (red cap "Shallow Creek") at the southerly corner of the said 293.72 acre Goolsby tract, in the northeasterly line of Farm to Market Road No. 2705 and at the beginning of a curve to the right having a radius of 5679.58 feet a central angle of 01° 47' 54" and a chord that bears N 31° 40' 57" W, 178.26 feet;

THENCE, along said curve to the right an arc distance of 178.26 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set (red cap "Shallow Creek");

THENCE, continuing along the northeasterly line of said Farm to Market Road No. 2705 as follows: N 30° 47′ 00° W (Reference Bearing), 1832.02 feet to a 5/8° iron rod set (red cap "Shallow Creek") and N 29° 41′ 00° W, 899.86 feet to a point for corner at the westerly corner of the said 293.72 acre Goolsby tract and the southerly corner of the said 181.79 acre Goolsby tract from which a 1° iron pipe found bears N 71° 25′ 12° E, 1.09 feet;

THENCE, N 29° 41' 29" W, along the northeasterly line of the said Farm to Market Road 9.86 feet to a point for corner at the beginning of a curve to the right having a radius of 904.94 feet a central angle of 64° 44' 00" and a chord that bears N 02° 41' 00" E, 968.89 feet;

THENCE, along said curve to the right an arc distance of 1022.41 feet to a point for corner;

THENCE, N 35° 06' 24" E, along the southeasterly line of the said Farm to Market Road 1345.40 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set (red cap "Shallow Creek") in an old county road bed at the northwesterly corner of the said 181.79 acre Goolsby tract from which a 1/2" iron rod found bears S 67° 42' 20" W, 185.20 feet;

THENCE, N 67° 42' 20" E, along the northwesterly line of the said 181.79 acre Goolsby tract and with the said old county road bed (no longer in use) 2032.11 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set (red cap "Shallow Creek") at the westerly corner of a Cemetery as described in said Volume 1080, Page 721 of the Deed Records of Limestone County, Texas as a 1 acre tract;

THENCE, with the said Cemetery tract as follows: S 02° 00' 52" W, 247.48 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set (red cap "Shallow Creek") at the southerly corner of said Cemetery tract and N 71° 06' 19" E, 329.92 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set (red cap "Shallow Creek") at the easterly corner of the said Cemetery tract, an ell corner of a called 120.9 acre tract of land as described in Deed to Ed Ellis recorded in Volume 132, Page 398 of the Deed Records of Limestone County, Texas;

THENCE, along the northwesterly line of the said 181.79 acre Goolsby tract as follows; N 72° 00' 52" E, crossing the westerly cliff of a lake (old stone quarry) at about 30.00 feet, the easterly cliff of said Lake at about 470.00 feet and once again finding evidence of the said old county road bed at about 975.00 feet and continuing a total distance of 3055.02 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set (red cap "Shallow Creek") in said old road bed, N 89° 32' 57" E, 405.03 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set (red cap "Shallow Creek") in said old road bed and N 55° 18' 51" E, 279.19 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set (red cap "Shallow Creek") at the northerly corner of the said 181.79 acre Goolsby tract and at a curve in said Limestone County Road No. 480;

THENCE, S 21° 56' 53" E, along the approximate center of said Limestone County Road No. 480 and with the northeasterly line of the said Goolsby tracts 1208.91 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING AND CONTAINING 475.51 ACRES OF LAND MORE OR LESS.
