


#29-136 Tindal Treasure Forest

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TINDAL TREASURE FOREST

When people dream about owning land, they tend to picture the same things: a quiet forest full of towering hardwoods, a rocky creek that sings year-round, wildlife slipping through the timber, and a tucked-away cabin where the world slows down. This 71-acre tract in Elmore County delivers exactly that.

Mature pines and hardwoods cover the ridges. A scenic rocky creek winds through the property for roughly 1,400 feet, producing that soothing sound of water over stone that buyers always ask for. The wildlife sign is impressive—scrapes, rubs, and turkey tracks were abundant on our last walk through the property. Whether you're a hunter, outdoorsman, or someone who simply enjoys being surrounded by nature, this tract checks the boxes.

Tucked back in the woods is a small off-grid one-room cabin—nothing extravagant, but exactly what so many buyers say they want: a place to spend a night, get warm, play cards, or watch the fireflies drift through the clearing.

Despite its seclusion, the property is in a very convenient location: roughly 15 minutes to Eclectic, 20–25 minutes to Wetumpka, around 30 minutes to Lake Martin and Kowaliga, 45 minutes to Auburn, and approximately 55 minutes to Montgomery.

This property sits off the beaten path, offering the solitude that is becoming increasingly rare. Access has been via a permissive easement that has been in place with the adjoining landowner since the 1980s.
