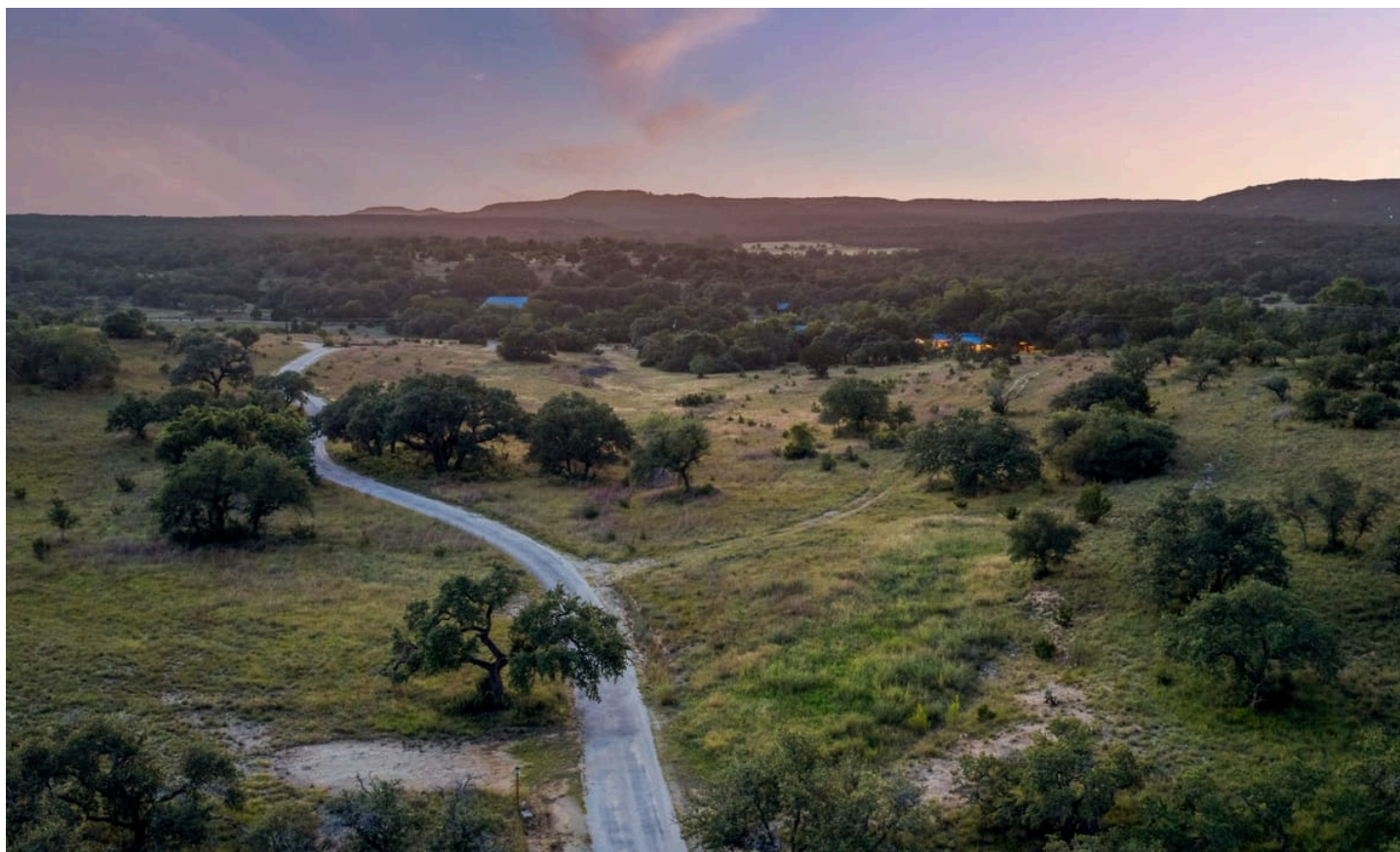

PROPERTY DESCRIPTION

For more than fifty years, the Reeves family has cared for Red Corral Ranch with a philosophy rooted in stewardship rather than ownership. Their commitment to improving the land through thoughtful wildlife management, holistic grazing practices, and native habitat restoration helped establish Red Corral as one of the early examples of wildlife-focused land stewardship in Texas. Every pasture, every grove of towering oaks, every native grass, and every stretch of limestone creek reflects that legacy of care.

The Experience

The first thing you'll notice is not the view. Although the views are extraordinary. It is the quiet. Morning arrives gently as sunlight reaches across the hills and wild turkeys announce the new day from distant ridges. Whitetail deer drift silently through the native grasslands while a light breeze moves through towering live oaks and ancient pecan groves. The demands of everyday life begin to fade almost immediately. This is a ranch that invites you to slow down.

Spend the afternoon exploring miles of ranch roads by horseback or UTV. Walk the limestone creek after a spring rain. Discover fossils embedded in ancient rock formations. Watch children skip stones across quiet pools of water or pick wild Mustang grapes in late summer, just as the Reeves family once did. Here, nature is not simply observed—it becomes part of family tradition.

Every season brings its own rewards. Spring awakens native grasses and wildflowers. Summer evenings are spent beside the pool or gathered beneath the shade of magnificent pecan trees. Autumn paints the surrounding hills in warm color while cool evenings invite conversation around the fireplaces of the historic Limestone Lodge. Winter reveals distant vistas with remarkable clarity and reminds us that beauty often lives in simplicity.

Then night falls. Far removed from the glow of the city, Red Corral reveals one of its greatest gifts. As darkness settles across the hills, countless stars emerge overhead until the Milky Way stretches from horizon to horizon. Conversations linger a little longer. The fire burns a little lower. It becomes difficult to remember why life ever needed to move so fast.

A Landscape Shaped by Stewardship

The beauty of Red Corral is not accidental. Healthy stands of native bluestem, Indian grass, switchgrass, and countless indigenous species blanket the rolling landscape. Majestic live oaks, towering pecan groves, Spanish oaks, Texas madrone, and redbuds create a diverse mosaic of woodland and open pasture rarely found in such balance.

Jones Hill provides one of the most breathtaking panoramic overlooks in the region, while the property's beautiful wet-weather creek winds through limestone banks that have quietly shaped this landscape for generations.

Throughout the ranch, an excellent internal road system allows convenient access without sacrificing the sense of exploration that makes every visit feel like a new discovery.

Healthy populations of whitetail deer, wild turkey, and countless native birds flourish here because the land itself has been allowed to flourish first.

The Lodge Compound - Once upon a time this lodge and surrounding improvements served as a wedding venue. The historic Limestone Lodge, handcrafted by German masons in 1934 using limestone quarried on the ranch itself, remains the heart of the property. Rich with craftsmanship and character, it has welcomed generations of family celebrations, weddings, retreats, and evenings spent around the fire sharing stories.

Nearby, the historic Cookhouse, chapel, guest accommodations, swimming pool, labyrinth, and beautifully landscaped grounds create an atmosphere unlike anything else in the Hill Country.

The Main Residence - The elegant hilltop primary residence captures commanding views in every direction, thoughtfully positioned to celebrate the extraordinary landscape surrounding it.

The Big Red Barn - The beautifully restored Red Barn offers endless possibilities for entertaining, creative pursuits, business operations, or memorable gatherings.

Stillpoint Cabin - As you travel through the dense woods, near the back of the property, you get a surprise bonus as this quaint cabin suddenly appears. What started as a father-and-son project has become a place of reflection, restoration, and peace. Here, mornings begin with birdsong instead of notifications, evenings end beside a wood-burning stove, and the outside world feels wonderfully distant.

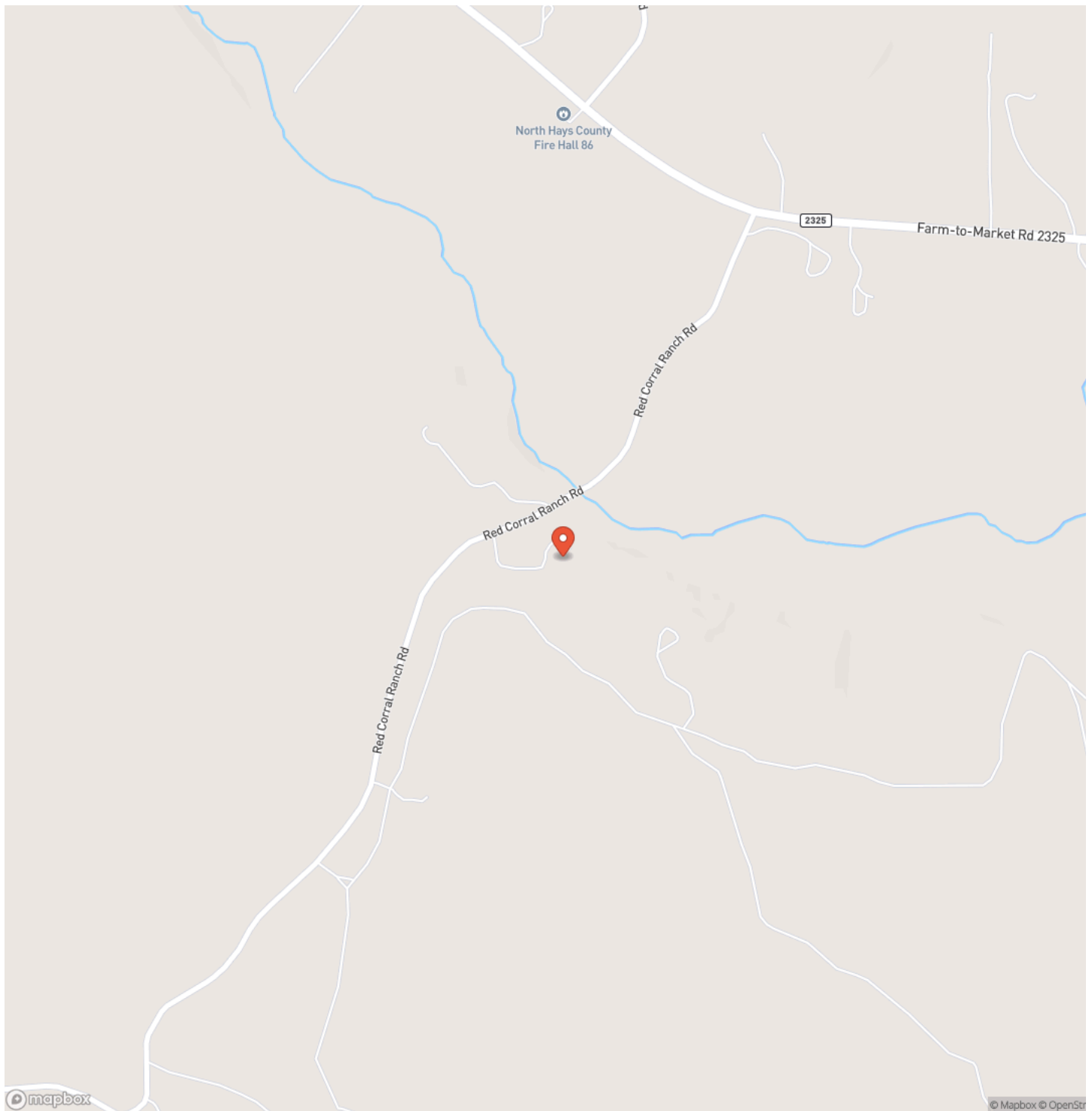

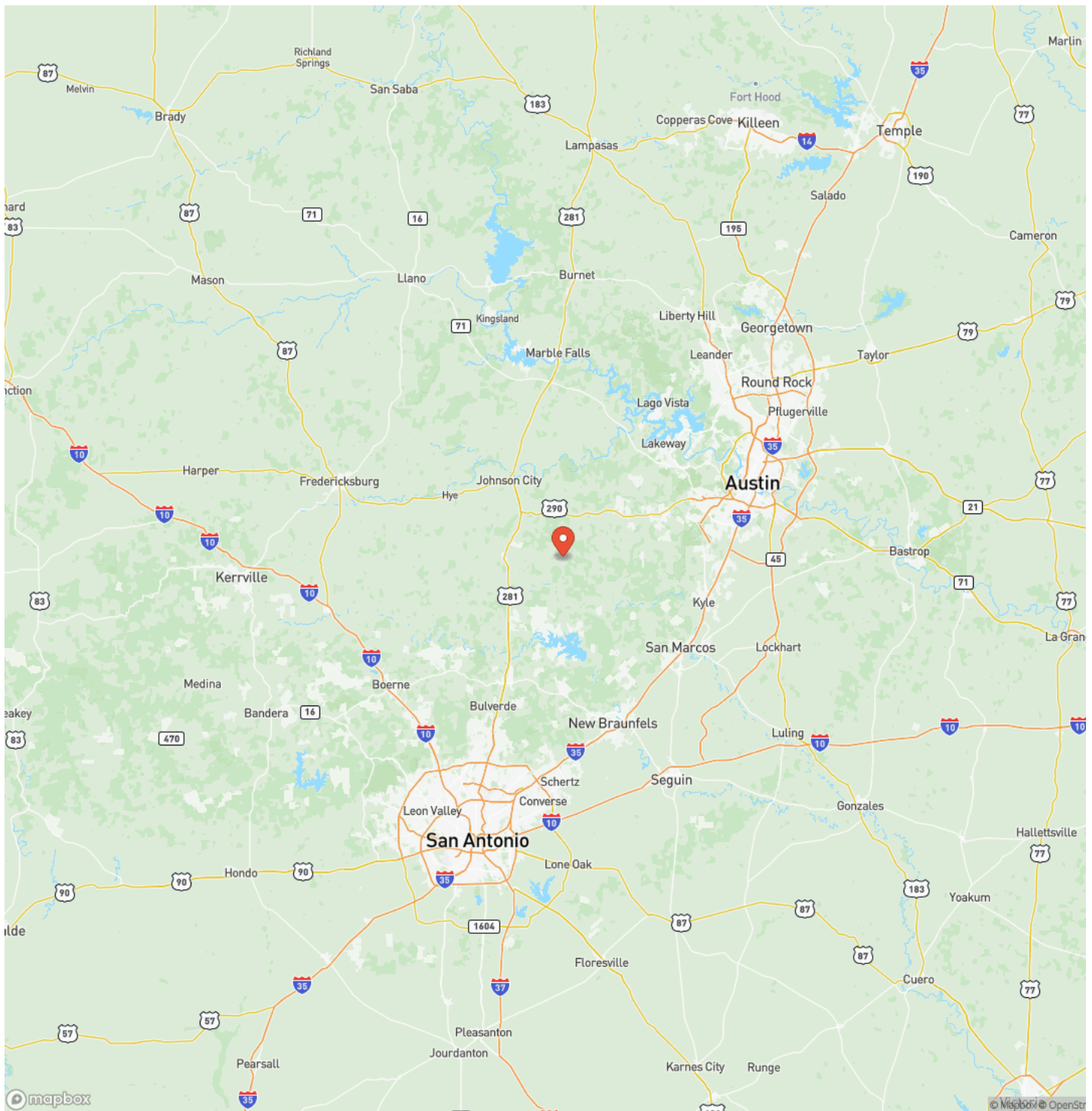
