INFORMATION REGARDING THE REAL ESTATE SELLER DISCLOSURE LAW

The Real Estate Seller Disclosure Law (68 P.S. §7301, et seq.) requires that before an agreement of sale is signed, the seller in a residential real estate transfer must disclose all known material defects about the property being sold that are not readily observable.
