**NARRATIVE**

THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED AT THE REQUEST OF BOB KIMBERLING. THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 33 AND MONUMENT THE NE, NW, AND SE CORNERS OF THE NE1/4SE1/4 AND THE NE AND NW CORNERS OF THE SE1/4NE1/4.

A SEARCH WAS MADE OF THE AVAILABLE RECORDS PERTAINING TO THIS SURVEY. MY RESEARCH DISCLOSED THAT THIS SECTION WAS ORIGINALLY SURVEYED IN JULY 1869 BY JOHN B. DAVID, U.S. DEPUTY SURVEYOR, UNDER CONTRACT NO. 131, DATED JUNE 8, 1869. SUBSEQUENTLY ON AUG. 4 & 5, 1913, VERNON GLAZE, COUNTY SURVEYOR RETRACED CERTAIN EXTERIOR LINES OF THIS SECTION AND SUBDIVIDED THE SECTION AS SHOWN ON RECORD OF SURVEY NO. 13G, RECORDED IN SURVEYOR'S RECORD BOOK B, PAGE 40. IN 1978, I RETRACED THE WEST BOUNDARY DURING RECORD SURVEY NO. 514. IN 1980, I RETRACED THE SOUTH BOUNDARY DURING RECORD SURVEY NO. 619.

FIELD MEASUREMENTS WERE MADE TO LOCATE EXISTING CONTROLLING MONUMENTS OF RECORD AFFECTING THE SUBDIVISION OF THIS SECTION. WE FOUND MONUMENTED CORNERS OF RECORD AT THE NE, SE, S1/4,

W1/4, AND NW CORNER OF THE SECTION, AND AT THE N1/16 CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS 32 AND 33 AS SHOWN HEREON. WE SEARCHED FOR BUT DID NOT FIND ANY SUITABLE CORNER EVIDENCE AT THE E1/4 CORNER NOR THE N1/4 CORNER. WE ALSO SEARCHED FOR BUT DID NOT FIND ANY SUITABLE CORNER EVIDENCE AT THE SE AND NE CORNERS OF THE SW1/4NE1/4, WHICH GLAZE INDICATED THAT HE SET IN SURVEY NO. 13G.

WITH NO EVIDENCE OF THE ORIGINAL CORNER OR GLAZE'S CORNER AT THE E1/4 CORNER, I SET THE E1/4 CORNER AT SINGLE PROPORTIONATE MEASURE BETWEEN THE FOUND MONUMENTS AT THE NE AND SE CORNERS OF THE SECTION. WITH NO CORNER EVIDENCE BEING FOUND AT THE N1/4 CORNER, I SET THE N1/4 CORNER AT SINGLE PROPORTIONATE MEASURE BETWEEN THE FOUND MONUMENTS AT THE NE AND NW CORNERS OF THE SECTION. WE THEN SUBDIVIDED SECTION 33 AND SET THE 1/16 CORNERS SHOWN HEREON.
