

The Stephen Family Ranch

1,132 acres in Palo Pinto County, TX

The Stephen Family Ranch is land that has been managed to produce cattle and wildlife. The entire property has been fenced and cross-fenced. These fences were built to last a lifetime with close T-posts, enough wires to keep the calves in, and cedar staves to add to the durability. This cattle operation has been set up with thought to create the ability to run cattle efficiently. The 2011 fires boosted the native grass production with 50% of the ranch being affected. The remaining centrally located land contains mature woods and ample browse for the abundant white-tail in the area. Over a mile and a half of Walnut Creek meanders through the ranch and provides towering oaks and elms for ideal turkey roosts. Several ponds survived the drought proven by the stocked bass and perch.
